

Second Lev Braschinsky Rapid Chess Memorial Tournament

Belonging to a yearly BEKO series, supported by The Estonian Chess Support Organization, the event itself will be organized by Viljandi CC Fellin together with the ECSO.

Time and Place

The event will take place in the March 17, 2012 in C. R. Jakobson Gymnasium, Riia mt. 91, Männimäe, Viljandi, Estonia (buses 2, 6 and 10). Free parking nearby.

Participants

Organizers reserve the right to limit the number of participants to 100 (one hundred).

Tournament System

FIDE rules will be enforced. 8 rounds will be played with 15 minutes + 5 additional seconds for each move for each player, using Swiss pairing system.

All portable devices must be switched off or in silent mode in the playing area. Annoying noises by any such device might result in a loss of the game according to a decision by the main arbiter. If that happens, the opponent must have a mating potential on board to be awarded a full point, otherwise he will get a half-point.

Being late to a game for 5 minutes or more will result in a loss of the game and a full point will be awarded to the opponent.

Tie-breaking criteria: Buchholz method excluding as many weaker opponents as necessary to break the tie, starting with all opponents.

Main arbiter: Mr. Gert Elmaste.
The results will be sent to FIDE.

Prizes

2nd place: 100 EUR

Best lady: 40 EUR

Best young player (born in 1994 or younger): 40 EUR

Best senior (born in 1952 or elder): 40 EUR

Best local player: 40 EUR

3 surprizes will be decided by drawing of lots, one of them between participating ladies. Prizes will not be combined (for instance, nobody could get the a prize for his or her good place and the prize for the best young player).

Fees

Participation fee: 7 EUR

Participation fee for young players or seniors: 5 EUR

The fees will be collected in cash before the event.

Participation is free for GMs, IMs, players from Viljandimaa and players personally invited by the organizers.

Participation fee for unregistered players is two times higher than for registered players.

Registration

All players must register in advance.

Unregistered players might not be allowed to participate, depending on the number of registered players.
