### **Tournament System**

Blitz 5+5 minutes for each player, 11 double rounds in Swiss system (22 games altogether). Random openings (in each round, every pair must start from the position seen on demonstration table).

### **Time and Place**

The tournament will be held in „Dorpat“ conference centre main hall (Turu St. 2, Tartu, Estonia) on Sunday May 20th 2012. Check-in from 9:45 to 10:30 in the same place, start of the games at 11:00.
