Dear Chess Friends,

we are sending you the invitation to the 21th International Chess Holiday to Prague – The Memorial of Professor Jaroslav Pelikán.

We invite not only families, but also individual chessplayers, chess groups and children groups with responsible guides. Also holiday-makers who do not play chess and who want to come and see Prague and Bohemia are welcome.

Jaroslav Pelikan /*1927 +1997/ was one of the tireless chess organizers in the Czech Republic who devoted his time and most of his energy mainly to young people. He was living in a small town in Central Bohemia, in Cesky Brod and he was working there. He was a teacher of foreign languages and later he became a headmaster of a grammar school. He participated in the organization of Grand Prizes which were very popular in the 60s and 70s. Under the leadership of Mr. Pelikan the chess team of Cesky Brod won the prize of Zajecice several times since 1964. It was the prize of Czech chess championship. Under his leadership a small town with population of 5,000 people had the team which took part in very important tournaments of chess league. But the best achievement of the last period of his life was the organization of International Chess Holiday where closed tournaments took place. We can say that it is a real world rarity.

<u>The International Chess Holiday differs from other chess</u> <u>tournaments in some measure:</u>

<u>1.</u> We do not use Swiss system of playing. We form closed groups and each one consists of 10 players.

2. We live and play chess in the same building, we organize chess holiday under the same roof.

3. We prepare special entertaining programmes for the participants of the tournaments as well as for all the other guests.

4. We are eager to create good relations and friendly environment for our guests.

ChessTournament Programme:

<u>Chessplayers-holidaymakers – Rapid R</u>

The chessplayers-holidaymakers play only in the mornings /Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday/ ca. 3 hours a day, 1 hour for a whole game /rapid or fast chess/.

<u>Chessplayers who want to play more chess than to make holiday –</u>

M Master tournaments: DWZ/ELO Rating 2000-2400

K Master candidate tournaments: DWZ/ELO Rating 1800-2200

H Main tournaments:DWZ/ELO Rating 1600-1900

 $\underline{\mathbf{V}}$ Secondary tournaments: DWZ up to 1700 or without ELO

Master tournaments and Master candidate tournaments are the closed FIDE tournaments. Main tournaments and Secondary tournaments are national tournaments.

All tournaments (M, K, H, V) – each player 2 hours for a game, altogether 4 hours for a game without adjourned games – 9 rounds. /2 rounds: Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday, 1 round: Monday, Wednesday, Friday/ All the tournaments will be divided according to the chessplayers' grade.

Prize fund: 4150 Euro / 100 000 Czk Prize in Master tournament FIDE:

- 1. prize 200 Euro
- 2. prize 120 Euro
- 3. prize 40 Euro

Every chess-player gets a money prize or a souvenir prize.

Accommodation, Board and Price:

All chess tournaments are realized at the IRIS HOTEL**** in Prague (*www.hoteliris.cz*). This hotel **** is situated in a quiet area of Prague, next to the sport facilities of Sports Club Slavia such as a swimming pool. It is possible to reach the centre of the city i.e. Wenceslaw Square and Charles Bridge in about 20 minutes by 3 tramlines in the daytime and 2 tramlines at night without changing. In the close vicinity of the hotel there are many shops and restaurants.

The price includes a hotel accommodation -7x bed and breakfast (single,twin,double and triple rooms). The rooms are with the bathroom or shower, W.C., a minibar, a TV set with satellite reception, a telephone, Wifi internet (gratis) and a safe (gratis). The rooms are air-conditioned. Apart from it the price includes the tournament entrance fees, prizes in the chess tournaments, a farewell party on board a cruise boat and all trips for non-chessplayers and chessplayers-holidaymakers (excursions to Loretto -a pilgrimage place with Treasure Chamber and a tower with carrilon, to Chvaly chateau <u>www.chvalskyzamek.cz</u>, to the National Gallery with a new exhibition, to the view-tower of Petrin, all-day trip to Nelahozeves Lobkowicz chateau and the birth-place of Anton Dvorák).

Price for one week 2011:

8650 Czk / ca 360 Euro for 1 person
8300 Czk / ca 345 Euro for 1 person students, retired and regular participants
7950 Czk / ca 331 Euro regular participants retired, students

Above-mentioned prices are calculated in Czech crowns and they will be converted into euros according to the given rate of exchange. At the present rate of exchange is 1 Euro = 24 Czk.

If you want to have a single room with your own bathroom, you will pay 1750 Czk / ca 73 Euro a week in addition to the basic price.

You can order lunch and dinner:

Lunch: a daily offer of soup, main dish, dessert cost 100-150 Czk / ca 5-7 Euro. Dinner: soup, main dish and dessert cost 210 Czk / ca 9 Euro.

If you come some days earlier or if you want to stay some days longer, you will pay for l person 850 Czk/ca 35 Euro /1 night bed and breakfast/, one single room costs 1100 Czk/ca 45 Euro.
