

Janis Mileika CM (1936-2010) was an influential chess coach from Jēkabpils who encouraged a generation of youngsters to express their creativity. Here is a position from a game from the semi-final of the Riga Championship in 1963. White is a pawn down but has seen more deeply into the position. His first move is clever, but it is the second move which forces Black to resign.
