

XL Rilton Cup 2010-12-27 - 2011-01-05

Stockholm's Chess Salons, Ringvägen 9 C, Stockholm, SWEDEN

(Metro station: Zinkensdamm)

Rilton Cup is Sweden's biggest and most famous international chess tournament. The tournament was initiated by a donation from doctor Tore Rilton and since 1985 the tournament is financially safe. The challenge prize, donated by Skandinaviska Enskilda Banken, is a Rilton medal in genuine gold. The tournament has over the years been very helpful for the Swedish juniors.

Stockholm's Chess Federation welcomes all chess players to the 40th Rilton Cup.

This year's tournament, with a prize fund of more than **120 000 SEK** (about 12 000 euro), will be played in two groups: Rilton Cup and Rilton Elo.

Rilton Cup and Rilton Elo is Elo registrated and play 9 rounds FIDE-Schweizer.

Send your entry with name, address, country, Elo rating and Elo-ID by mail, fax or e-mail, no later than the 18th of December to: Stockholm's Chess Federation, att.: "Rilton Cup".

When you register, the information should contain name, adress, date of birth, club, Elo rating, national rating, e-mail and phone number where you could be reached during the tournament.

The first 100 registered players in each group are guaranteed participation. It is possible to book a room at Scandic Hotel Malmen through Stockholm's Chess Federation.

The prize is 590 SEK for a single room, 690 SEK for a double room and 790 SEK for a doubleroom with an extra bed. All prizes is per night, and breakfast is included in the prize.

Entry fees:	600 SEK, 300 SEK for players born 1990 or later.
