Players whose application will be registered after 15th of July 2011 will pay additional charge of 5 LVL.

Financial Prizes

The guaranteed first prize is 700 LVL (1000 EUR). 8-12 general prizes depending on the number of participants. Special prizes for best women, junior (born 1995 and later) and senior players (born 1946 and earlier). In case of at least 100 participants the guaranteed

prize fund is 3000 LVL. For international players receiving a prize over 100 LVL (~150 EUR) a 25% tax deduction will be withheld and transferred to the state budget in accordance to Latvian law.

General prizes are shared using the Hort system, special prizes are not shared. Players can receive only 1 prize.

Regulations: Swiss system, 7 rounds, FIDE rules
