2<sup>nd</sup> chessboard: a boy or a girl (born in 1997 & younger)

3<sup>rd</sup> chessboard: a boy or a girl (born in 1997 & younger)

4<sup>th</sup> chessboard : a boy or a girl (born in 1997 & younger)

TIME: 60 minutes for each contestant.

Teams will play by the Swiss system - 7 rounds.

Teams will play in the same crews, on the same chessboards during the whole tournament.

## 7. PRIZES

All teams will receive diplomas and prizes.

1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> places - cups

7<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> places - souvenirs

1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> places - all players and coaches will receive medals
